General Information and Instruction to Authors

The Jahangirnagar University Journal of Statistical Studies, a publication of the Department of Statistics, publishes original contributions based on the research study in statistical theory in the widest sense of the term and its applications in various fields. The contributors of this Journal are requested to follow the notes mentioned below:

- Submission of a manuscript in JUJSS implies that the work submitted has not been published elsewhere. The author(s) is(are) solely responsible for factual accuracy of the contribution, statement made, and opinion expressed in the article.
- Manuscript should be of professional standard but intelligible to general readers. This should be submitted to the Executive Editor in triplicate, computer composed with adequate space and margin.
- Manuscript should include a suitable title; name of authors with affiliation and email of corresponding author; abstract (max 300 words); keywords and phrases; background; methodology, results; conclusion and discussion; references.
- No article will be published if it does not conform to the referencing style specified for the Journal. The journal follows the following referencing style in-text and reference list citations. For details visit <https://libguides.murdoch.edu.au/APA/home>
 - The in-text citations should include the surname of the author(s) and date of publication only. e.g. (Akhter, 2017) or (Akhter&Khan, 2017) or (Akhter et al, 2017) or (Akhter&Khan 2017; Kabir, Khan&Rahman, 2015)
 - If there are multiple works by the same author these are ordered by date e.g. Akhter (2007, 2013, 2017), if the works are in the same year they are ordered alphabetically by the title and are allocated a letter (a,b,c etc.) after the date. e.g. (Akhter, 2017a), (Akhter, 2017b)
 - The reference list must be on a new page at the end of the document and arranged alphabetically by name of first author.
 - The basic structure to cite a journal is: Author name, initial(s) Year. Title. *Journal title*, Volume Number(Issue number, optional), page numbers. ISSN, DOI or Retrieved from URL
e.g. Granich, et.al. 2017. 90-90-90 and Ending AIDS: Necessary and Feasible. *Lancet*, 390(10092), pp. 341–343. DOI: 10.1016/S0140-6736(17)31872-X
 - The basic structure to cite a book is: Author name, initial(s) Year. Title (edition). *Publisher Location: Publisher*. ISBN, DOI or Retrieved from URL
- If the paper is accepted for publication, soft copy (MS Word & PDF format) of the final version of the manuscript will be required.
- All communications including manuscript submission, status of manuscript can be done/notified through email. The soft copy should be in MS Word&PDFformat and submitted through email to the Executive Editor.
